NEWS PIECES

Channel Airways are reported to be interested in acquiring HS748 G-ATAM. Church Fenton Vampire T.1 XD437/52 was delivered to Cambridge Aerodrome Fire Service on 25/7. The Leeds UAS and 3 MP are now based at Church Fenton. Buccaneer XH487 left Ferranti's on 6/8 for Holme and is considered unlikely to go back to Turnhouse. Canberrae T.4 XH583 overhauled at 60MU at the end of June was inadvertently painted as XP583. Vampire T.1 WZ459/71 from 7FTS which crashed at home on 28/2 has now been returned, wrecked to Church Fenton. Hull UAS Chipmunk WZ846 departed in early April and was replaced by WD331 in June. It is believed that BAA are considering a name change and the fleet for 1967 is understood to be Air Britannias, ten Viscounts and one or two Ambassador freighters.

HUTTON CRANWICK Avro 688 G-ADHU is currently at Dringhouses Grange in the hangar once occupied by G-AJRE. It will move to "Gipsy Landing" on the Skerne-Cranwick road at Hutton Cranswick after the harvest.

Comments :- The above list speaks for itself but a word or two on some of the Squadron badges may be of use:- No.16 Sqn. (Canberra) comprises a pair of crossed keys and No.80 Sqn., also a Canberra unit has a large bell on the fin, the other Canberra on show (WK145) was from 98 Sqn. which aircraft had the Squadron badge - a "three headed dog" on the nose. The Victor from Marham, 57 Sqn., had a large "57" in red on the fin and Hastings from 24 Sqn. bear the arms of the City of Bath on the nose. The Gnats of 4 FTS are identified by the badge on the fin showing on a white disc on the fin. The Javelin from 228 OCU had a pair of birds superimposed on a white disc on the fin while the Argosy from 267 Sqn. had a winged horse insignia on the fin.

N.B. Correction - The Gnats of 4FTS are identified by the badge on the fin showing a Pyramid and a Palm Tree.
