THE YORKSHIRE HELICOPTER SQUADRONS - By R.D.Allison

Formed in April 1953, No.275 Sqn. moved from North Weald to Linton-on-Ouse in June and yet again to Thurnaby.

Initial aircraft was the Sycamore HR.3 (eg. XD196, XD197) though by 1954 the Squadron was equipped with the major Sycamore version - the HR.4. While at Thurnaby the Squadron was divided into flights, these being detached to Leuchars, Acklington, North Coates and Horsham St. Faith. Aircraft in use at this time included HR.3 XD186, XD187 and HR.4 XE309, XE315.

For a short while squadron aircraft carried code letters, some being XD197/A, XE317/B, XG506/F, XG508/H and XG509/J.

During 1957 the squadron moved to Leconfield and in mid 1959 the first Whirlwinds were received, although it was not until 1960 that the Sycamores were finally withdrawn.

Prior to this, in September 1959, 275 Sqn. was re-numbered becoming No.228. Aircraft used by 228Sqn. included Sycamores XJ364, XJ915, XJ919, XL823, Whirlwind HAR.2 XJ430 and Whirlwind HAR.4 XD163, XD183, XJ412, XJ761, XL113. In addition the Squadron also used an Anson for communications.

Towards the end of 1962 No.228 began re-equipping with Whirlwind HAR.10. Some of the first aircraft being XD182, XJ724, XP403 and XP404.

On 1st September 1964, the Squadron was again re-numbered, now becoming No.202. Currently No.202 Squadron is still based at Leconfield, though the detachments have changed since Thurnaby times. These are now:- Leuchars "C" Flight, Acklington "A" Flight, Leconfield "B" Flight and Coltishall "D" Flight.

Two Whirlwinds are detached to each of these Flights, returning to Leconfield, as necessary, for repair or overhaul.

In use are XD165, XD182, XD186, XD188, XJ414, XJ723, XJ724, XJ729, XK969, XK990, XP403 and XP404.
