## THE CALEY GLIDER

Extracted from 'Hawker Siddeley News' by Alan Anderson

Sir George Caley (1773 - 1857) is universally recognised as the 'Father of Aeronautics' and it was he who produced the first man-carrying glider. The glider was fully depicted and described in the 1852 issue of 'Mechanics Magazine'.

Early in 1973 Anglia Television decided to produce a documentary film about the life of Caley, and his glider in particular. Commander John Sproule, a glider enthusiast, was engaged as design consultant. By using the techniques and materials available to Caley, the glider was re-created and test flown at Holme on Spalding Moor. The pilot, Mr Derek Piggot, had the glider airbourne at a speed of 28 m.p.h. while it was being towed behind a car. Several tows were made for filming purposes. Eventually the glider was taken to Caley's original launch site at Brompton Dale near Scarborough. The final glide across the valley was at some 40 feet.

The device is a monoplane, sail wing glider with a fixed cruciform tail at slightly negative incidence. There is a three wheeled, boat-like car surmounted by the 460 square foot wing which has no ailerons. The whole thing is steered by a long steering oar which is moved left and right as a rudder, and up and down for elevation.

The programme is due to be shown during the summer months on ITN.

## AROUND THE AIRLINES

### Air Anglia

At least one additional F-27 Friendship is presently being negotiated for by the company from a Near East operator, due to the high load factors being experienced on scheduled routes. In the first month of operations from Leeds/Bradford, over 500 passengers were carried.

A southbound morning and a northbound evening weekday service are to be introduced through the LBA from November, with Amsterdam connection via Norwich.

The long awaited introduction of flight AQ204 on Saturday mornings should have commenced as we close for press. During June, the Daks on AQ203 have continued to rumble into the LBA on Sunday afternoons.

Leeds/Bradford is the number one diversion airfield for Air Anglia flights into Tees-Side and Hull/Leconfield.

### British Airways - Northeast

Due to the fatal tail failure of a Columbian Viscount recently, all British Airways aircraft have to undergo ultra-sonic tests to the tail. All the Northeast division's 806's have had tests made, but not all the Channel Islands division's 802's have. This resulted in G-APEY and 'EX' positioning from Leeds/Bradford to Manchester to help out on June 29th and 30th respectively.

### Dan-Air

It is understood that BAC One-Elevens will operate the Luton - Leeds/Bradford - Glasgow route with effect from November 1st.

Seneca G-BEPX arrived on the 19th, was noted local flying on the 29th and may be a new resident. Locally built Jodel D.11 G-BAZM made it's long awaited first flight on the 20th. New airline equipment noted was Air Herald G-BBXJ of BIA on the 2nd and Friendship G-BCDO on the 25th of Air Anglia. Plenty for the military enthusiasts this month with the Blue Eagles sioux's on the 6th, departing to Blackpool on the 7th. Sea Devon XJ350 on the 3rd is a 78lsqn machine, used callsign 'Navair 820', and was from Lee on Solent to Lossiemouth. Devon C2 XG496 on the 19th is 'K' with the RAE at Farnborough and used callsign 'Nugget 10'. Devon C2/2 VP962 on the 20th is a new aircraft with 207sqn using callsign 'Ascot 1453' going to Bristol. Scout XW280 on the 21st went to Otterburn, and on the following day two more XW284/A and XT264 went to Topcliffe. On the 27th all three returned from Otterburn to Castle Don. The two Hercules on the 23rd were unable to drop their parachutists at Totley and had to offload them at the LBA; the aircraft were from Mildenball to Lyneham.

Heron G-ANNO of Fairflight on the 2nd was from Biggin Hill to Maastrict. A carpet show in Harrogate attracted the French contingent at the end of the month, F-BRFY came from Cherbourg on the 22nd and returned there on the 25th, F-BVHC was f/t Mieux and night stopped carrying c/n 12129, F-BTAU of TAT was from Le Touquet to Ipswich, F-BRAS and F-BNPY were both f/t Le Bourget, and finally F-BUZM was f/t Mieux. Earlier in the month the new Flanders A/S Seneca F-BVEE was from Castle Don to Lille and the Air Wsateels Jetstraem was f/t Lille. Cessna 337 PH-NOS on the 11th was from Hilversum to Brough and did the return flight the following day, the owner is Dutch TV. On the 14th Cessna 207 N1630U was from Blackpool n/s to Sberburn, it is c/n 0230 and a Brussels demonstrator. Cessna 414 D-ICEN was in twice on the 18th clearing customs from Bremen to Barrow/Walney Island and return.

New Britishers were Aztec G-BCCE of British Ropes, Aztec G-BCEX of Mooney Aviation on the 18th from West Midlands to Blackpool, Cessna Carters Sort Drinks Cessna 337 G-BBKJ from Northair. New from Flight Line at Doncaster were Travelers G-BBUF and G-BCCJ on the 27th and AA1B G-PWZ on the 24th.

A first visit of type was the Trislander G-BBNL of Loganair on the 24th and 25th. DC-4 LN-MOJ of Bergen Air Transport was inbound from Ostend on the 16th and outbound to Stavanger on the 17th with the Cameron Iron Work's Cargo.

#### HELICOPTER ACTIVITY
