AROUND THE AIRLINES

Air Anglia

Dakota 4 G-AGJV had a false fire warning when it had just taken off from Norwich bound for Leeds/Bradford on Sunday 21st July. The emergency services were alerted at Horsbem St Faith for the aircraft's return, but there were no injuries to crew or passengers. The trouble could not be located by the airline's technicians and AQ204 had to be cancelled.

British Airways - Northeast

At a time when scheduled services are generally on the increase at Leeds/Bradford, the company's frequency to Amsterdam has been halved. NS501/NS502 on Tuesdays and Thursdays, and NS503/504 on Sunday have suffered as a result of this measure.

Transavia Holland

The operation of Boeing 737-200C's by the airline this year is programmed for medium range flights. However during the bulb season in Holland next year flights into Leeds/Bradford with a Boeing 737 certainly are possible according to an airline spokesman. The Caravelle fleet will be replaced entirely by 737's. Five 737's will be operated in 1977.

Severn Airways

No additional news has been received regarding the proposed Leeds/Bradford service. However a demonstration was given at Lulsgate to the company by Britten Norman using Trislander 9L-LAQ on May 17th.

ON THE LIGHTER SIDE

At Sherburn the aero club celibrated it's tenth birthday on Saturday 20th July by inviting local residents to visit the airfield and have free flights. It was a way to say "thankyou" to the locals who might have been disturbed over the years by the club's aircraft.

Aerochecks at Tees-Side are in voluntary liquidation.

Seen at Pocklington on the 21st July was Condor G-AYZT. Does any reader know if this is based here for glider towing? Any info would be appreciated by the movements editor.

Over now to Harrogate where the airstrip at Bogs Lane has been ordered to close. The Great Yorkshire Show on the 11th July produced (in addition to smelly livestock) the Shell Mex BP Cameron S-31 G-BAOY, Hughes 269 G-AVVS displaying police signs, and JetRanger G-AYMX giving pleasure flights. Two gliders were on static display, one was unidentified and the other was BGAl445/'492' c/n 13051 a Schleicher ASK-13

Falco G-AVUJ is for sale.

At Doncaster the Schreibe SF23A Sperling reported in the March issue of YAN has now been registered to Doncaster Sailplane Services as G-BCHX; it has c/n 2013 and is ex D-EGIZ. New aircraft registered to the Grumman Aircraft Agency Flight Line are:-

Other new aircraft with the company are Cherokee G-ATOO and Cessna 150 G-AVGM.

Four Bassets were delivered to Nothair at Leeds/Bradford from Leconfield on July 8th, all were non-radio but were accompanied by B.206 G-AZL. They are XS771, XS772, XS779, and XS782 due to become G-BCJA/B/C/D. The selling price as advertised in 'Flight' is £2,750 each non-radio. It is understood that two un-airworthy Bassets will be brought by road from Kemble in the near future. Beagle B.206 G-ATYC was sliced up on July 5th/6th and taken away for scrap on the 6th.

A Turbulent G-AWDH crashed on take off from Oxenhope on July 8th. The pilot was seriously hurt when the aircraft struck a stone wall at Upwood Farm.

Cessna Aerobat G-AZXF belonging to Mr David Green crashed into the Humber on July 14th near Reeds Island, 500 yards from the south bank. Mr Green was picked up by a Goole barge which was at the scene with an aircraft from Kirmington and a Whirlwind from RAF Leconfield. In the latter half of July the Aerobat was noted at Hull's Alexandra Dock.

Cessna F.150L G-BAEU made an emergency landing at Micklefield on the central reservation of the A.1 road on July 13th causing damage. It was taken to a service area where it was dismantled to return to Sherburn by road on the 14th.

Cessna Aerobat G-BKID of Northair was written off on July 14th after stalling and crashing at Barton. The remains were removed to Leeds/Bradford on the 16th.

At Sherburn on July 20th, Auster 5 G-AKPI was noted in immaculate condition wearing the markings NJ703 and in full military regalia.

Minicag F-BGJP was collected on May 6th from Barton by Minicab G-AVRW and flown to Bagby. It is now painted up as G-BCER in RAF camouflage and markings. This may be the 'small low wing camouflage aircraft' seen parked in a field just north of Rington by a Yorkshire Aero Club flying instructor between July 10th and 26th. (q.v. Page 3 July issue YAN)

Flying Flea G-AFFI was on display at Leeds/Bradford on July 14th for the benefit of the branch meeting, and again from July 22nd to August 4th at the Yorkshire Post building in Leeds for an 'Unusual Hobbies' exhibition. The aircraft has been built by YAN readers Steve Langfield and Dave Allan.

The Chipmunk which crashed near Wombleton a few months ago was carrying out spinning exercises.
