Jet Ranger G-CPTS arrived on the 4th in primer and non-radio, it is for YLA to spray up and then it will move to Skipton with Northfield Carpets. Navajo G-BSTN on the 17th is a new machine for Boston Deep Sea Fisheries. N552CC on the 23rd is a Citation 2 and was not visiting Northair. Friendship G-BIGW of Air Anglia made its first visit on the 27th and their Fellowship PH-MOL made its first visit on the 29th.

#### NORTHAIR

Chancellor G-PRIX arrived on the 2nd and was delivered to Team Lotus on the 10th. Two interesting Cessna's visited during the month, N756KM on the 12th is a TU206G c/n 04152 and N756JM on the 19th is a U206G c/n 04128, the latter was fitted out with attachment points for fleats! The BCA Aero Commander which has been stood outside Northair for some time now awaiting a buyer was taken to Ringway by BCA on the 1st August for a demo and crashed on landing. The new Conquest is reported due for delivery in November.

#### LOCAL NEWS

INTER EUROPEAN AIRWAYS This is a new airline set up by the Bradford based tour operator Intasun Ltd., to operate their charter flights. They have ordered three Boeing 737's and hope to have them in service for the 1979 summer season starting from next May. It is a possibility that they will operate from LBA, although a recent report in 'Flight'? gave their probable base as Gatwick.

The BA-4B's under construction should, according to a Hornet Aviation "spokesman", be flying by July 1979. Klemm L-25 G-AAHW has left, after engineering and a test flight by Hornet, for a German Aviation Museum, in Dusseldorf.
