The best month for a long time with no less than 41 different foreigners visiting. Starting on the 1st with Navajo 00-VLH which was a 310CR model with c/n 31-7812073 and it n/s to the 3rd, also on the 1st Aerostar 00-MRF had c/n 601P-0554-238 and the Commander 114A-GT was on a crew ferry flight (see later). Citation N485CC on the 5th brought in the President of Cessna to visit Northair. On the 6th Chancellor N36896 was on delivery to Northair and it has c/n 0247, it rapidly became G-BGVA. Also on the 6th was another of the US Army U-25's 22261 which night stopped. Night stopping on the 11th was a very old Cessna 402B OH-CHL c/n 0018 which started life as N5418M then progressed through LN-RTZ, SE-FRT and LN-TVM before reaching Finland. The 13th brought the expected Tenneco visitors in the shapes of BAC 1-11 N504T and G-2 N62CB, they were joined on the apron by King Air E90 N60253 c/n LW-321 but this is in fact Bristol based and a UK Register candidate. The 14th brought my personal star of the month, Dove SE-GRA which was yet another night stopper. This was at one time a regular visitor to Yeadon as G-AMZN of Richard Johnson & Nephew and was the prototype Dove 6 with c/n 04437. Air Alpes visited on the 16th with Beech 99 F-EVJL which n/s along with Navajo PH-GPL. Beech A36 00-KAA on the 18th war found to have c/n E-445 whilst the brand new Irish Chancellor on the 20th had c/n 0016. Navajo F-BYCQ on the 21st was another golden oldie with c/n 31-491, it was registered in 1978 having been in Senegal as F-OCPC since 1970. USAF Aero Clubs were represented by Cessna F150 N17342 on the 23rd and F150 N962L on the 26th. Rounding off the month in style we had Beech 3TM CF-QPD on the 29th, this is c/n CA-164 and is a Beech C45 built for the Canadian Armed Forces. It was on a return flight from Tanzania to Canada when the weather over the Atlantic was reported bad, so since the pilot has relatives locally he came direct here from Nice to await better weather. Cherokee G-AWEX was on delivery to a new owner at LBA on the 1st and Commander N5891N was used as crew ferry. Chancellor G-BGVA left on delivery to Colt Cars on the 21st but this is thought to be just a loan caused by the grounding of the Conquest in the States and the subsequent non-delivery of G-CCCL. Commander G-BCLK arrived back from Leavesde in an immaculate new colour scheme on the 22nd and Cessna 402 G-BCBI also arrived back from Leavesden in a new colour scheme on the 26th. The night mail run changed hands at the beginning of the month, the last Dakota flight was scheduled for the 1st. In the event G-AMRA arrived to do it but went u/s so it was not run and the Dakota stayed until the 4th. On the 4th Air Ecosse took over the route operating Bandeirantes.

Eagle Aircraft Services arrived on the 13th with the Duchess G-BGHP which stayed to demonstrate through to the 17th. AIRLINE NEWS

AIR ANGLIA: Latest reports show that Air Anglia plans to operate a LBA/Gatwick service using Bandeirante aircraft from the beginning of November.

AIR ATLANTIQUE: The airlines second DC-6A/B, G-SIXA (ex OY-DEM, c/n 45326) arrived at Coventry on 2 June having flown from Sondre Stromfjord, Greenland, laden with 6 tonnes of spares. It is expected to remain at Coventry until G-SIXB returns from Manston, and will then depart for its UK C of A. G-SIXB will now almost certainly be used cattle flights, its seats having been removed, following C.A.A. refusal to approve them for passenger carrying.

AIR EUROPE: will begin operations from Manchester and Birmingham in the Winter Season 1979/80, for Intasun. Flights from Manchester should start in October. The airline is the first new airline of its kind to be formed in this country for 13 years, and has operated from Gatwick since inaugurating services on 4 May.

BRITISH AIRWAYS: have extended their lease on the Transavia Boeing 737-2K2C's, PH-TVD and 'TVE for a further 12 months and have taken a similar lease on a third. The former aircraft are in British Airways colours but retain their Dutch registrations. Both are dry-leased and used on routes from Heathrow to Europe, while the third is wet-leased and operates scheduled services from Gatwick to Iberian holiday centres. The airline has ordered its first Boeing 747F freighter for delivery in Sept 1980 and it will be powere by RB211-524's.

BRITANNIA AIRWAYS: have been awarded a trooping flight contract by the Ministry of Defence for service between UK airports and Germany. A number of similar flights have already been operated from Teesside and Luton to Germany, but the new contract will provide for about 15 flights per week.

BRITISH MIDLAND: FH-227B/QC, G-SKYA has been used on the nightly freight services from East Midlands to Amsterdam, BD209/210F, replacing the Eastern Airways Dakota. Aircraft are positioned almost daily from Lydd.

DAN-AIR: have leased HS748 SRS2A, ZK-MCF from Mount Cook Airlines for the summer. The aircraft is c/n 1697 and was first flown on 7 May 1971, and from October 1973 to its joining Mount Cook in Sept 1976, was operated by Howard Hughes. It has been restored asG-AYYG with Dan-Air titles, but retains its basic Mount Cook livery.

LAKER AIRWAYS: The C.A.A. has given permission to extend 'Skytrain' into a full advance booking service. The authority stated that the changes were "a reasonable commercial response in a highly competitive market", and accordingly dismissed objections raised British Airways and British Caledonian. The new rules will allow the normal no-reservetion system to continue, but additionally Laker can now offer a full reservation servic and a Skytrain excursion service with guaranteed seats both ways.
