SOCIETY NEWS

The July meeting was held on a Thursday evening for the first time and 37 members attended to hear our guest speaker Tony Hallwood, LBA's Commercial and Aviation Development Director. Tony began by outlining his aviation career to date – in the 1980s he worked for Cosmos (who were then no. 2 to Thomsons), later moving to Airtours. He subsequently moved from tour operations to the airport side, starting at Bristol in 2003 where he spent 5 years before coming to LBA in 2008. The importance of the airport to the Leeds City Region was then stressed and the benefits of its continued development discussed - creating employment, greater access to overseas markets and the growth of inbound tourism, especially with Ryanair and Welcome to Yorkshire. More PR will also help to raise the profile of LBA.

A major problem our airport has had for many years has been leakage of passengers from this region to other airports, notably MAN. Tony described the situation at Bristol 10 years ago – at that time they had a leakage rate of 60% to Heathrow and Gatwick which was much the same as LBA's is to MAN now. Bristol has since captured half of that back and LBA is aiming to do the same. The airport is expecting 5 million passengers annually by 2014-15, double the current numbers. The terminal improvements are part of the plans for this and Tony showed images of these as part of his presentation. Questions and answers followed a short break, topics raised included potential new routes – Germany is the top priority with Frankfurt, Berlin and Munich being favoured, also LBA's income – currently balanced between aeronautical and commercial revenue. This was very enjoyable evening and there is no doubting Tony Hallwood's passion and belief in the future of LBA. This is what is needed to help bring future plans to fruition and I am sure we can look forward to some interesting times ahead.

The figures for April 2010 are somewhat meaningless due to the Volcanic Ash closure of airspace. HOWEVER, these figures are impressive when you consider that there were no commercial flights for SIX Days. A reduction of only 3.24% must be one of the best in the country.

With regard to International routes and the significance of the Ryanair services, we have 13 new routes and no loss of routes over April 2009. The best performing routes compared to last year are Fuerteventura (+591%), Murcia (+58%), Faro (+56%), Palma (+16%) and Malaga (+15%). The poorest routes were Las Palmas, Paris, Chambery, Geneva, and Brussels all of which had a 40% reduction.

Domestically, the Gatwick route is still classed as a new route when compared to April 09. Not surprisingly all the other routes had an average reduction of 39%, so analysis of individual destinations is rather meaningless the month.

Perhaps surprisingly we only had 3 diversions away from the airport and we received 2 diversions.

Fewer passengers using Leeds Bradford Airport based Jet2 dented profits at its parent company Dart Group plc. Chairman Philip Meeson described the year to March 31 as 'reasonably satisfactory' for the aviation and logistics group, in spite of challenging conditions for Jet2. While group turnover fell slightly from £439m the previous year to £434m, pre-tax profits fell by around a third from £33.5m to £22.2m, due to lower margins at Jet2 as a result of lower customer demand. Financial results for Jet2 are not pulled out from the overall group performance.

Jet2 suffered from weaker customer demand for its passenger services, especially during the off-peak and winter months, with flights to skiing destinations particularly affected. Mr Meeson said early action was taken to reduce capacity and frequency in order to control potential losses. During the year, it carried more than 3.1 million scheduled and charter passengers, with load factors up two percentage points to 80% and yields (average fares) down. The group's expanding tour operator, Jet2holidays.com, sold more than 64,000 packages, and this was planned to grow substantially. Mr Meeson said: 'With the contribution of passengers from Jet2holidays alongside our other income streams, we feel optimistic that, provided we are flexible, continue to innovate and offer really great-value fares, our aviation business will prosper.'

Ryanair is to expand its winter schedule at Leeds Bradford Airport, despite last month announcing an overall 16 percent cut in winter capacity across the country. The airline will operate two aircraft on 13 routes, including new services to Barcelona, Dusseldorf, Gdansk in Poland and Fuerteventura. Ryanair operated just three routes from Leeds Bradford last winter. The expansion should see its traffic from the airport grow to one million passengers a year, and could see Leeds Bradford grow to 3.3 million passengers in the year to next March.

Flybe celebrated the first anniversary of its flights between Gatwick and Leeds Bradford yesterday. The regional budget airline said the route has provided a 'key link' between Yorkshire and the south-east and has been a 'roaring success' since it was introduced in June 2009, shortly after bmi axed its flights between Heathrow and Leeds. Over 60,000 passengers have used the Flybe service in its first year, with the route operated by a Bombardier Dash 8 Q400 aircraft. Mike Rutter, the carrier's chief commercial officer, said: 'Air services from Gatwick to Leeds Bradford are of great strategic importance to Yorkshire and the north of England in general, so we're delighted to be celebrating the first anniversary of our service connecting the two airports.'

'We know from passenger feedback how important this link is for business and leisure passengers alike in Yorkshire and this has been reflected in the performance of our service in its first year.'

Thomas Cook has announced 17 new routes from 13 UK airports for next summer. Leeds/Bradford will get receive a new Kos service.

The Lord Mayor of Leeds, Councillor Jim McKenna, has officially opened Leeds Bradford Airport's new Premier Lounge. The lounge, which can cater for more than 100 people, has business facilities including a self-contained meeting room as well as free Wi-fi access and a self-service bar area with snacks. The pay-as-you-go lounge offers departing passengers the chance to enjoy comfortable surroundings and business facilities, irrespective of the airline they are travelling with, their class of travel or their destination. It is the latest phase of the airport's £70m development plans which include a two-storey extension to the terminal building and internal improvements.

AIRPORT NEWS

Doncaster/Robin Hood Airport passenger numbers increased for the second month running in June, new figures show. Summer sun destinations were the most popular, with Palma, Alicante, Dalaman, Faro and Katowice the top five routes. Some 109,000 passengers used the airport last month, a 16 percent year-on-year increase. Mike Morton, airport director, said: 'We are now looking ahead to our winter routes for 2010/11 and should be announcing these in the coming months. Thomson Airways recently announced extra capacity for summer 2011 which is thanks to strong forward sales.'

Durham Tees Valley Airport new owners have stated boosting passenger numbers will be the first priority for the Canadian firm that took a majority stake in its owners Peel Airports the Northern Echo reports. Vancouver Airport Services has reached an agreement with The Peel Group to buy a 65 percent share in Peel Airports Limited, which operates Liverpool, Robin Hood and Durham Tees Valley airports. Craig Richmond has been brought in as chief executive of the company and the newspaper reports that Durham Tees Valley will be his initial focus, after passenger number more than halved in 2009 to 288,000, down from 647,000 in 2008. A number of airlines pulled out and the aviation industry has been hit hard by the economic downturn. Mr Richmond said: 'We will start right away meeting management and the team and we are starting at Durham Tees Valley. The big focus will be to turn it around. Our intention is to increase the passenger traffic. We will be doing everything we can to bring passengers back and make the airport profitable for the long term.'

Manchester has installed a new "eco" art installation. Peter Kay, Oasis stars Liam and Noel Gallagher and indie group The Stone Roses will have their name permanently etched in the feature. Work has already begun on a glass-covered walkway that will feature names of the North West's most famous people and places. Hundreds of names will be 'hidden' in a giant word search as part of the walkway, which is being built to link terminals one and three. Its designers are hope people using the walkway will try to solve the puzzle, which aims to celebrate the best of Greater Manchester and pay tribute to its heritage.

The design of the walkway will also help the airport in its bid to be 'carbon neutral' by 2015 by using third generation LED lighting to cut energy consumption by about 40 percent, airport bosses say.

Manston owners Infratil, have changed its name. Kent International Airport will now be known as Manston, Kent's International Airport. Tom Wilson, chief executive of Infratil Airports Europe, said: 'The airport has a long history, and the local community has always known it as Manston. We therefore felt it was important to include the name, but to help inbound travellers identify where Manston is, we have added 'Kent's international airport. Under previous owners, the airport has had several names in recent years, but we feel that the name we have chosen is suitable for both outbound and inbound travellers.'

Stansted Airport has won approval to take Airbus A.380's from Emirates Airline on divert in a move that could offer enormous long-term potential for the Essex hub. The airport has received permission from the Civil Aviation Authority to take Code F aircraft, including the Airbus A.380. The permission to take Code F aircraft allows airports with big enough runways, available stands and flight slots – backed by the right level of service capability – to take the world's largest wing-size jets if they are forced to divert as a precaution or if the scheduled destination airport is unavailable for any reason. While this is unlikely to trigger an immediate upsurge in business, it does offer longer term potential. The ability to take for Code F aircraft now allows Stansted to bid for business – both passenger and freight – from the elite airlines that use the A.380.

AIRLINE NEWS

British Airways has become the first UK airline to take delivery of a new long-range Boeing 777-300ER, the world's largest twin-jet aircraft. The plane is quieter and more fuel-efficient than its predecessors and enables airlines to operate longer non-stop flights (the 'ER' stands for extended range). Some models have a range of almost 17,400 kilometres. When it enters service later this year the 297-seat plane will feature a brand new interior layout with redesigned World Traveller and World Traveller Plus cabins. Passengers will be able to make use of a new in flight entertainment system featuring more than 230 television programmes, 70 films, 400 CDs and larger screens. BA said that the aircraft will showcase the 'future face' of the company. The airline's chief executive, Willie Walsh, said: 'Our first Boeing 777-300ER aircraft reflects our continued commitment to deliver the best travel experience to our customers. We will add two more B777-300ERs by the end of this year and three more by early 2012. All these new aircraft generate significantly less CO2 emissions per seat than their predecessors and reinforce our commitment to reduce our carbon footprint.'

Eastern Airways have named an aircraft after veteran comedian Ken Dodd. A special caricature of the famous son of Knotty Ash has been painted on the fuselage of one of the airline's 29 seater Jetstream 41 aircraft as tribute to the star. His famous welcoming line - 'How tickled I am!' - is written below the caricature. Dodd, 82, was present at the unveiling at Liverpool Airport. He said he was 'delighted' the airline was naming a plane after him. He said: 'I'm also feeling very plumptious about it. I've had a thrilling and exciting afternoon at Liverpool Airport.' Darren Roberts, from Eastern Airways', said: 'We're thrilled to have one of our aircraft named after Ken Dodd. Ken is a comic legend in Liverpool, a leading icon and supporter of the city and airport and we felt this was an appropriate way to pay tribute to him on our first anniversary of flights from Liverpool. Passengers climbing the aircraft steps will see his caricature and name as they board our Liverpool flights, and the aircraft will also fly throughout the UK and Europe.'

Jet2 has announced 'an eclectic selection' of new routes from Newcastle for 2011. They include a return to Krakow, which had been unavailable in recent months from the airport, and flights to the popular French city of Toulouse. The five new routes are: Alicante, starting on 1 April 2011, Faro, starting 2 April. Prague, starting 5 November 2010, Krakow, starting 28 March and Toulouse, starting 22 May 2011.

AIRCRAFT NEWS

Thomson and First Choice will be able to offer package holidays from airports such as Bristol direct to Honolulu once they start using the Boeing 787 Dreamliner, TTG Live reports. Thomson Airways managing director Chris Browne said that was one of the routes that could be offered when its Dreamliners are deployed at regional airports. Mr Browne said the holiday company intends to operate its Dreamliners from Gatwick, Manchester, Birmingham, Bristol, East Midlands and Glasgow airports.

The arrival of the aircraft, on display at the Farnborough Air Show last month, will massively expand TUI's options for their long-haul leisure programme. The Dreamliner's 8500 nautical mile range will allow the holiday company to offer direct flights to destinations such as Hawaii, as well as the hugely popular Thai resort of Phuket, which Thomson has so far been unable to offer from the UK.

Mr Browne said recent research for the company showed 43% of those questioned picked Hawaii as the top destination they would want from their local airport. Other destinations likely to be added to the Thomson and First Choice programmes are Costa Rica and Brazil in central and south America, as well as others in Asia and Africa. He also revealed that the Dreamliner would open up a market for seven-day long-haul packages because of its potential to reduce jet lag. Boeing believes the aircraft will significantly reduce the physical impact of flying because the air supply will be more humid so will leave passengers less dehydrated, and the lighting can be set to mimic the sunset and sunrise times of the destination

OTHER NEWS

A 181kg man planning to take a flight to see his dying aunt was kicked off the plane because he was too fat. Sandy Russell was denied permission to travel because his 52-inch belly was overflowing into the next seat and the armrest could not go down. He had just boarded the Air Transat plane from Gatwick to Toronto when a stewardess escorted him off. The 32-year-old was told he would have to pay for two full-price tickets if he wanted to fly.

Mr Russell could not fly as he did not have the extra £928 for the fare. His aunt Judy died of bowel cancer in Canada two days after he was due to see her. The airline has refunded the cost of his ticket.

The cost of hiring a trolley at Luton Airport has doubled to £2, and there's no refund, the Mirror reports. Around 10million passengers who use the airport each year will be affected by the price hike, introduced last Month, just in time for the peak holiday season. T h e increase has been imposed by trolley operator Bagport, which will reap huge extra profits. A spokesman for the airport, owned by Spanish firm Abertis, said: 'This has been done at Bagport's discretion. Luton Airport has neither asked for this increase nor will it stand to benefit from it.' We find this hard to believe, given the airport would have given the contract to the company.

A passenger told the newspaper: 'It's a racket. When you consider airport parking charges, taxes, check-in fees and the cost of eating and drinking while waiting for what is often a delayed flight, the add-ons now cost almost as much as the flights. Trolleys at Heathrow are free to use while a £1 or € refundable deposit is needed at Gatwick and Stansted. Last year Luton, Britain's fourth-busiest airport, became the first in the country to charge for dropping off passengers. A number of other airports have now followed suit.

Life before RAF Leeming by Jim Stanfield

Opened as a grass airfield in 1930 its first landing was a Puss Moth in October of that year. Then the airfield was known as Londonderry/Newton House because of its proximity to the Newton House Hotel, in Londonderry village. The hotel became a weekend retreat for wealthy people arriving in their new fangled private aeroplanes. By 1935 the airfield was so successful that one of the first flying clubs opened here under the name of Yorkshire Aviation Services Country Club. Flying lessons were 35 shillings per hour and its telephone number was Bedale 87. By 1938 the war clouds in Europe were forcing an expansion of the RAF and in that year the airfield and surrounding land was purchased by the Crown. Work started on what was to be a standard bomber airfield named RAF Leeming. It opened in June 1940 and the rest is well documented history
