
# Blackburn Botha Crash.... Steve Langfield

Not the finest aircraft from the Blackburn stable, the Botha was designed as a 4 seat reconnaissance and torpedo bomber. In testing stability issues were quickly discovered, the view from the cockpit was poor, and with its two Bristol Perseus engines the aircraft proved to be under powered. Nevertheless 580 Bothas were made though it was quickly withdrawn to be used in secondary roles.

On 24th of May 1940 Botha L6160 was in the hands of the ATA being ferried from the Blackburn factory at Brough, near Hull, to Silloth near Carlisle. The pilot encountered poor weather not long after taking off and made a precautionary landing at Yeadon Aerodrome where he remained for the rest of the day. On the following day, 25th May, the weather appeared to have improved so the aircraft took off again to continue its flight. The precise details still remain unclear but it would appear that, shortly after its departure from Yeadon the weather quickly closed in. The pilot was flying in the Horsforth area and in cloud. Realising he was flying towards two houses on a hill the pilot made a banked turn to the right but collided with a stone wall. Sadly the pilot, 1st Officer John Taberna Wilson Clark, died in the collision, he was 28. The exact site of the crash is not known but is believed to be in the Layton Lane/Layton Road area on the edge of Rawdon and Horsforth. The pilot is buried in Yeadon cemetery.

# Mount Cook Flight....

Our long haul holiday this year was to New Zealand with Scenic Luxury Cruises and Tours. Not many flights this year as there were to be no internal flights within New Zealand, so no review of the flights,though I must say Air New Zealand was a far better experience than Singapore Airlines.

Prior to arriving in New Zealand we had booked a helicopter ride over the Franz Joseph Glacier on the South Island. Unfortunately, on the day of the trip there was low cloud meaning the helicopter trip was cancelled.

However, on our route from Dunedin to Mount Cook we were given the opportunity to book an aircraft flight around Mount Cook, so we decided to pay our money and see what it was like. My only previous flight in a small aircraft was a trial lesson some 30 years ago from Leeds Bradford Airport, and I hated it!



The seven of us arrived at Pukaki Airport in Twizel which is on the intersection of Harry Wigley Drive and De Havilland Drive. Harry Wigley was a pilot, entrepreneur, and pioneer of the New Zealand tourism industry. There wasn't a terminal building at all and the office for Air Safaris was a small portacabin type building



Our aircraft landed as soon as we arrived. It was ZK-SAE GippsAero GA8 Airvan with seating for 7 + the pilot, with one of us in the co-pilot seat (Not me!). Our pilot Matthew Croft (who looked very young!) greeted us and gave us the opportunity to cancel, because the weather at the other side of Mount Cook was poor so we wouldn't see the Franz Joseph or Fox Glaciers, but we would see others. So we all decided to go ahead with the flight.


Matthew gave us a safety briefing and I remembered to give him an Air Yorkshire Aviation Society pen.





We took off quite slowly and the winds seemed quite strong, so we gained height slowly and we eventually ended up at 10000 feet, though Pukaki Airport is already at an elevation of 1575 feet. We headed towards Mount Cook, going over canals used for hydroelectric plants as well as braided rivers which are a common sight in New Zealand. We flew over Lake Pukaki, Tasman Glacier as well as being quite close up to Mount Cook. We were buffeted around a bit and Matthew said it was quite challenging flying the aircraft but in general it was quite smooth.





As were started our decent, I really did wonder what the procedures would be if the engine failed as we were flying between the mountains with nowhere to land in an emergency.



We landed at Mount Cook airport after some 50 minutes in the air and we had had, the most amazing time with some incredible views. I am actual quite glad the helicopter ride was called off as I am sure this experience was far more memorable

# British Airways – An Airline and Its Aircraft Volume 1: 1919-1939- The Imperial Years By R.E.G. Davies Published by Paladwr Press

This book was destined to be the last, by renowned aviation historian Ron Davies. He had previously written a series of airline histories, all published by Paladwr Press. They are classics of their time. Regretfully, Mr. Davies died before Volume 2, of the above title could be written.

However, this publication is a worthy account, not just of the pre-war British Airways and its antecedants, but the early history of British airline operations.

The story is breaks down naturally into bite size chunks, dealing with each airline and and aircraft type, operating services during the 1919-1939 period. There are a lot of interesting facts to learn, but the pace is easy going. The text blends seamlessly with a large number of illustrations, photographs, maps, and charts. The illustrations, drawn by aviation artist Mike Machat are both delightful and evocative.

Just about every pre-war air route is mentioned in the text, around Britain, Europe and further afield. This includes the early operations to India, The Far East and Africa.

Services from airports long since closed, make good reading. Every pioneering airline is well documented, including Imperial Airways, Railway Air Services and the unfortunately named Spartan Air Lines. It seems there were even flights to Lundy Island, in the Bristol Channel, provided by Lundy and Atlantic Coast Airlines.

Although published some 20 years ago, the historic nature of the contents, makes this volume current and relevant today. In short, the book is a delight. Good clean copies can sometimes be found on Ebay, or at Collectors' Fairs. Investing a few pounds in one, would be money well spent.

#### LEEDS/BRADFORD NEWS

Tuesday 17th June was the opening day of the new terminal extension at LBA. the opening marked the end of the first phase of the airport's ongoing £100 million terminal expansion project. The extended terminal introduces a new baggage reclaim area and an updated passport control zone, both equipped with newer technology. These upgrades are intended to support more streamlined processing for inbound passengers. An increase in seating capacity by around 83% also forms part of the development, alongside expanded food and beverage options within the departure area. The updated terminal also features two premium lounges, including the newly introduced Six Eight One Premium Lounge. This space offers travellers a quieter area to wait for flights, with seating and refreshments provided, including menus using locally sourced ingredients. It's always a pleasure to provide details of new routes and increased capacity on existing routes from LBA. This month I am able to announce 2 new routes and increased capacity on an existing route

1st Easyjet have a new twice weekly service from Leeds/Bradford to Barcelona operating every Wednesday & Saturdays. Flights start from October 29th, 2025 The flights will be operated by Easyjet Europe, by Barcelona based aircraft. Currently the Easjet app will not allow bookings on this service after the end of March (see Malaga service details below) Unfortunately Easyjet will finish their LBA Malaga service at the end of October, but will commence services for 2026 on April 1st.

2nd new service is by Ryanair, twice weekly to Warsaw Chopin. This two will be a twice weekly service, every Monday and Thursday, with flights commencing October 27th. But Ryanair already fly LBA to Warsaw I hear you see. Well yes they do, but the services operates into Modlin airport, which is much further from the city, and from personal experience I can tell you has poor public service links. Ryanair are the only airline operating from Modin, and seem to be gradually expanding at Chopin.

3rd report Sun Express, who for the peak summer months, during 2026 will be adding an weekly service to their Antalya route. This will bring the service to 5 weekly.

#### **AIRPORT NEWS**

London Stansted Airport has submitted a planning application to raise its annual passenger cap to 51 million, seeking to maximize use of its existing runway without exceeding its current flight limit. The proposal, lodged with Uttlesford District Council, outlines a 20-year plan to grow within the airport's existing boundary and its permitted limit of 274,000 annual flights. "We have already kicked off our five-year £1.2 billion [\$1.63 billion] investment program to transform the airport, and if this application is approved, we will be able to unlock even more local opportunities and improvements over the next 20 years," STN managing director Gareth Powell says. "Making the best use of our existing runway will help create more jobs and training schemes, better facilities for passengers and provide more seats to an even greater choice of destinations."The plan includes upgrades aimed at improving sustainability and transport links, such as switching to 100% renewable energy and increasing the share of public transport access. "We've listened carefully to all the feedback from our neighbors, which has helped shape our plans to grow London Stansted in the most sustainable and responsible way possible," Powell adds. According to owner Manchester Airports Group, the expansion would support 4,500 new jobs, improvements to M11 Junction 8, funding for local bus services and roads, upgrades to the Stansted Express rail service, and the expansion of Stansted Airport College. Stansted currently has planning approval to grow to 43 million passengers per year. In

2024, it handled 29.8 million passengers—its busiest year to date—surpassing the previous record of 28.1 million in 2019. The airport is already building a £600 million extension to its passenger terminal, part of the broader £1.2 billion upgrade. The extension will add 16,500 m² (54,100 ft²) and include a 14.3-megawatt onsite solar farm.

Australian multinational infrastructure investment firm Macquarie Asset Management, a unit of Macquarie Group, has acquired stakes in three UK airports. The holdings in Bristol Airport, Birmingham Airport and London City Airport were acquired from the Ontario Teachers' Pension Plan. The Canadian pension fund has also offloaded its 39% stake in Brussels Airport to Flemish investment firm PMV. Macquarie has acquired a majority 55% stake in BRS, a 26.5% stake in BHX and a 25% stake in LCY. The LCY acquisition closed at signing, while the stakes in BRU and BHX "are expected to reach financial close by Q4 2025, following the satisfaction of regulatory approvals." according to a Macquarie statement. The financial terms of all three transactions are undisclosed, as are terms of the Ontario Teachers' Pension Plan's sale of its stake in BRU to PMV. "Each of the three [UK] airports offer unique propositions and catchment areas, which present significant growth opportunities for airlines and a wide range of business partners," Macquarie said. "Through its investment, Macquarie is committed to supporting the airports over the long term to expand their route networks, further enhance passenger experience and work closely with management teams and stakeholders to implement the airports' sustainability strategies." Ontario Teachers' Pension Plan acquired its stake in BRS in 2007, in BHX in 2008 and in LCY in 2016. It acquired its stake in BRU in 2011. "Collectively, Birmingham, Bristol and London City airports serve over 25 million passengers each year and are a valued home for leading regional and global airlines," said Gordon Parsons, a senior managing director at Macquarie Asset Management. "Each airport has a unique path for growth ahead, and we're supportive of the management teams' plans to deliver enhanced customer experiences and more routes to each of the communities they serve."

#### **AIRLINE NEWS**

IndiGo is accelerating its international expansion with plans to launch service to 10 new destinations, including long-haul routes to London, Copenhagen and Athens. As reported last month, India's largest airline by market share will begin its Western Europe operations with flights from Mumbai to Manchester, England, on July 1. The route will operate three times per week using Boeing 787s damp-leased from Norse Atlantic Airways. Speaking ahead of the International Air Transport Association (IATA) Annual General Meeting in New Delhi, IndiGo CEO Pieter Elbers said the airline will add 10 more international destinations during the 2025-26 fiscal year, describing the move as "yet another important step" in the low cost carriers's global growth strategy. The rollout of routes to London and Copenhagen will follow later this year and into early 2026, as IndiGo takes delivery of additional 787s under a six-aircraftagreementwith Norse. The airline also plans to launch flights to Athens over the next 12 months, supported by the introduction of Airbus A321XLR aircraft into its fleet.

Qantas has completed the second of three Project Sunrise long-haul research flights, after a Boeing 787-9 landed in Sydney after a non-stop flight from London. The aircraft, operating as flight QF7879 and carrying 50 passengers, landed on Friday at lunchtime local time in Sydney after a 19 hour 19 minute journey. The research flight, which follows a non-stop New York to Sydney flight last month, is aimed at improving crew and passenger wellbeing on ultra long-haul services. The direct flight reduced total travel time by around three hours compared with current one-stop services. It flew across 11 countries and had fuel for about 1 hour 45 minutes of flight time when it landed. Qantas is looking at aircraft selection for a possible 2023 launch of scheduled service between the east coast of Australia and London and New York. The arrival of the research flight coincides with the 99th anniversary of the founding of the Australian icon. The "Flying Kangaroo" was founded in rural Queensland in 1920 as Queensland and Northern Territory Aerial Services.

Qatar Airways has finally abandoned the year 2022 firm order of 25 Boeing B737-10 aircraft , that was aimed at creating a gap filler fleet to the absence of Airbus's A321neos. Qatar Airways and Airbus were involved in the famous and rare legal dispute as a result of paint quality issues with the carrier's A350 fleet. Under the directions of Qatari Aviation Regulator-QatarCivil AviationAuthority (QCAA), Qatar Airways was forced to ground several examples over surface degradation concerns, requiring repairs. In January 2021, Qatar Airways sought more than\$600 million in damages from Airbus, ultimately leading to thecancelation of the aforementioned deal for 50 A321neos. Airbus removed Qatar's 23 remaining A350s from its orderbook. Both theA321neoandA350orders were reinstated in early-2023 after the two partiescame to an agreementover the lengthy dispute. They released a statement, saying: "Qatar Airways and Airbus are pleased to have reached an amicable and mutually agreeable settlement in relation to their legal dispute over A350 surface degradation and the grounding of A350 aircraft. A repair project is now underway and both parties look forward to getting these aircraft safely back in the air."

Ryanair will end all flights to and from Maastricht Aachen Airport (MST) in the Netherlands after failing to reach a new commercial agreement with the airport. Ryanair plans to cancel five routes and remove 150,000 annual seats as it accused MST of becoming "one of the most expensive airports in Europe" due to "excessive cost increases." Ryanair also pointed to the Dutch government's aviation tax, which has increased to nearly €30 (£36) per passenger, calling it a "soaring" and "illogical" burden. "These significant cost increases make Maastricht Airport one of the most expensive airports in Europe and completely uncompetitive compared to other countries and low-cost airports elsewhere in Europe," said Jason McGuinness, Ryanair's chief commercial officer, late on May 29. "Maastricht's sky-high costs are damaging its connectivity, as evidenced by the airport's failure to recover its traffic post-COVID, lagging far behind the rest of Europe at just 50% of pre-COVID traffic in 2024—a figure set to fall even further following Ryanair's exit," McGuinness added. Ryanair said the capacity removed from Maastricht will be redeployed to airports in countries such as Italy, Poland and Sweden, which the ULCC claims are reducing airport charges and scrapping aviation taxes to encourage traffic growth.

Turkish Airlines, has announced it is adding additional flights from the UK & Ireland as part of its summer schedule offering more choice for those looking to visit Türkiye or fly globally viaiGA Istanbul Airport. From London Heathrow there will now be 47 weekly flights, an additional two, to Istanbul and London Gatwick will also see an additional two weekly flights brining the total to 28 flights per week to Istanbul. Manchester Airport gets three additional weekly fights between the North West and Istanbul bringing the total to 28. Birmingham Airport also gets a boost with four extra flights bringing the number of direct weekly flights to Istanbul to 14. For Irish travellers the current 18 weekly flights to Istanbul from Dublin increases to 21 and in Scotland, the weekly total rises from 10 to 14 flights per week from Edinburgh

#### OTHER NEWS

Passengers Who Unbuckle Before the Seatbelt Sign is Off Now Face Fines Starting May 2 2025, Turkey's Civil Aviation Authority has rolled out a new regulation aimed at passengers who violate the fasten seatbelt sign and unbuckle or stand up before the seatbelt sign is switched off while the plane is still taxiing. Impatient violators can expect to be slapped with fines of up to 2,603 Turkish lira (about £80). This rule applies to all flights into and within Turkey and is designed to improve onboard safety and reduce stress on cabin crew. Airlines are required to notify travellers during flight announcements, and flight attendants are authorized to report violations.
