
These will be announced at meetings and in the monthly magazines.

There will be a prize draw in July where three lucky respondents will receive a gift voucher of their choice.




Overall, how satisfied are you with your membership of Air Yorkshire?

Overall, how would you rate the monthly presentations? 49 responses




How satisfied are you with the Aviation Academy as our venue for presentations? $_{\rm 49\,responses}$




Have you attended any trips/visits?




If you have attended any trips/visits, how would you rate them overall? $_{\mbox{\scriptsize 30 \, responses}}$



Overall, how would you rate the magazine published by the Society? ⁴⁹ responses




Would you like to see more or less of these subject areas in your magazine?




Do you attend the AGM?


If you have attended an AGM at Multiflight, how would you rate them?






JUNKERS 88 CRASHES INTO HOUSES IN IDLE, BRADFORD

During the Second World War 70 German aircraft were lost in Yorkshire, this is the story of one of them. At 11.15pm on the night of 4th/5th May 1941 twelve aircraft of unit 2/KG106 took off from their base at Schiphol, the Junkers Ju88-A5 with identification markings 0656 M2+DK was to be the ill fated aircraft.

The unit were tasked with laying mines in the Irish sea off Belfast where the Americans had recently landed war material. This particular aircraft's flight path took it over Yorkshire and shortly after crossing the coast they were intercepted by a Beaufighter, R2156 from 25 Squadron, which made an attack. The attacking Beaufighter was crewed by Pilot Officer Kenneth Hollowell and Sergeant Richard Crossman. Some accounts state that this attack occurred over Harrogate. The aircraft's observer reported to the pilot that the starboard wing had been hit and the engine was on fire, and after losing height and releasing the bomb load two of the crew bailed out in order to reduce the aircraft's weight. This left the pilot and observer on board with the observer throwing heavy items from the aircraft in an effort to remain airborne. They saw four other fighters attacking them from above and below further damaging their aircraft and with it on fire the two remaining crew had no option but to bale out. Local residents of Idle were awoken by the sound of machine gun fire followed by the loud noise of a labouring engine.

At 00.45 the stricken aircraft crashed into a woodyard, owned by John Barker, off Jasper Street in Idle, a village 3 miles to the north of Bradford, reports state that there was a terrific explosion which shook many local houses. It also struck an adjoining row of four terraced houses centered on 13-15 High Street, Idle, two houses were destroyed whilst the other two were badly damaged by fire. Three civilians were killed in these houses and four others injured with one succumbing to their severe injuries a few weeks later. The Luftwaffe airmen landed across the north Leeds/Bradford areas. One landed in Farnley north of Otley, and was captured by a policeman patrolling on a motorbike, he took his prisoner on the pillion to Otley police station. The pilot landed in a field near Town Street Idle where he was found by a local youth who took

him to the police box in Town Street. Another crewman landed by the Ings public house in Guiseley. It is not clear where the fourth crew member landed but they were all taken prisoner. All four crew were taken to Otley police station prior to being transferred to Bradford Town Hall where they waited to be collected by the military authorities the next day.





The larger picture above shows one of the damaged houses and how the same site looks today. The picture below it shows how the middle row of houses has been rebuilt. The road in front is the High Street.

It is believed that RAF personnel removed the wreckage the next day except for an engine which was so deeply buried it was left where it landed and presumably remains there to this day. The demolished terraces have since been rebuilt but there is no memorial to the four civilians who lost their lives. There are two reports about this incident on You Tube entitled:

AIRPORT NEWS

East Midlands has agreed a deal with Chinese Cargo operator, Yun Express. This will be the first service by the operator to a U.K. Airport. The service was introduced the day the announcement was made. The airline ised Boeing 777 Freighters. Initially the service is twice weekly, but plans are in place to increase the service.

AIRLINE NEWS

Archer Aviation, in collaboration with United Airlines, has announced an innovative plan to launch an air taxi network in New York City. Using Archer's electric air taxi, Midnight, the network promises to cut travel times significantly, connecting Manhattan to nearby airports in just 5 to 15 minutes. Midnight is a piloted, electric vertical takeoff and landing (eVTOL) aircraft designed to carry four passengers. It produces far less noise and emissions than traditional helicopters, aligning with the city's push for sustainable transportation. The aircraft features 12 engines and propellers, along with redundant systems, to ensure safety levels comparable to commercial airliners. Archer is manufacturing Midnight at its facilities in San Jose, California, and Covington, Georgia. Archer plans to leverage existing aviation infrastructure, such as helipads and airports, to establish vertiports across the region. These vertiports will serve as

takeoff and landing hubs for Midnight. The company is partnering with infrastructure leaders like Atlantic Aviation, Signature Aviation, Skyports/GroupeADP, Modern Aviation, and Air Pegasus to develop and electrify these sites.

Global Airlines completed its inaugural flight, on May 15th, a non-stop journey from Glasgow Airport (GLA) to New York's JFK International Airport aboard a refurbished Airbus A380. The flight, which departed at 11:00 AM local time, marked the first-ever direct A380 service between Glasgow and New York. Onboard were a mix of journalists, aviation influencers, and early adopters eager to experience the airline's promise of a "Golden Age of Travel" Global Airlines, founded in 2021 by travel entrepreneur James Asquith, aims to disrupt the transatlantic market by focusing on luxury, service, and nostalgia. The airline operates its A380s under a wet lease agreement with Hi Fly Malta, allowing it to commence operations without its own air operator's certificate. The first aircraft in the fleet is 9H-GLOBL, which previously flew for China Southern Airlines. The airline's next scheduled service is a Manchester to New York JFK flight, departing on May 21 and returning on May 25. Global Airlines' ambitious plans include offering regular scheduled transatlantic services, challenging established carriers like British Airways and Virgin Atlantic. However, the airline faces significant hurdles, including operating in a market where many airlines are retiring A380s due to high operating costs and maintenance challenges. Despite these challenges, Global Airlines is positioning itself as a premium alternative in the transatlantic market. With its focus on luxury and customer experience, the airline aims to attract passengers dissatisfied with current offerings. As the airline continues to expand, the aviation industry will be watching closely to see if Global Airlines can carve out a sustainable niche in the competitive transatlantic market.

International Airlines Group (IAG) has confirmed a bulk order of 53 widebody aircraft. The order includes 32 widebody Boeing 787-10 aircraft for British Airways and 21 Airbus A330-900neo aircraft. IAG will likely deploy the Airbus aircraft flexibly across its carriers, Aer Lingus, Iberia, or LEVEL. Deliveries for the bulk order are scheduled to take place between 2028 and 2033. The order also includes options for future growth. British Airways has the right to purchase up to 10 additional Boeing 787-10s, while IAG can opt for up to 13 more Airbus A330-900neos. Of the 53 aircraft, 35 will replace older models or short-term leases, particularly for LEVEL, ensuring a more sustainable and cost-effective operation. The remaining 18 aircraft will support IAG's expansion in key markets

Ryanair CEO Michael O'Leary has suggested the airline could postpone the delivery of its Boeing 737 MAX planes, citing concerns over escalating tariffs. The next batch of aircraft, scheduled for delivery in August, could be delayed if import duties on aircraft are imposed. While the aircraft are key to Ryanair's growth, O'Leary emphasized they aren't needed until 2026. A delay could impact expansion plans, especially during peak summer months. However, O'Leary stressed that the airline would seek a fair solution with Boeing over who should bear the costs.

United Parcel Service is set to lay off 20,000 employees and close 73 facilities as part of a planned reduction in deliveries forAmazon.com, and amid the ongoing global uncertainty and trade war initiated by the current US administration under President Donald Trump. During the company's first-quarter investor call, management said the goal is to reduce Amazon's volume in its network by over 50% by June 2026, as the e-commerce giant's business "is not profitable for us, nor a healthy fit for our network." The company's air cargo division, UPS Airlines, based at Louisville International, operates 293 aircraft: fifty-twoAirbus A300-600Fs, twoBoeing 747-400(BCF)s, eleven Boeing 747-400FSCDs, thirtyBoeing 747-8Fs, seventy-fiveBoeing 757-200PFs, sixBoeing 767-300ER(BCF)s, fourBoeing 767-300ER(BDSF)s, eighty-fourBoeing 767-300Fs, one and twenty-eightMD-11Fs (currently on their way out, with three being retired this year).

AIRCRAFT NEWS

France has officially designated the first-ever Concorde, Concorde 001, as a historical monument, recognising the aircraft's groundbreaking role in aviation history and the nation's technological heritage. The announcement was made by French Culture Minister Rachida Dati, who praised the aircraft as a symbol of French innovation and industrial strength. Built in a Franco-British partnership, Concorde 001first flew in 1969 and is now on display at the Aeroscopia museum near Toulouse. It marked the beginning of a supersonic era in passenger aviation, entering commercial service in 1976 and flying elite passengers between Europe and the U.S. in just over three hours. Though retired in 2003 following a deadly crash in 2000 that killed 113 people, the Concorde remains a powerful emblem of aviation ambition. "This plane, a pioneer in supersonic flight, remains in our memories," said Dati. "Its preservation will provide future generations with an example of our aeronautical expertise and futuristic vision."

OTHER NEWS

Spirit AeroSystems hascompleted divestiture deal with Airbus, handing over multiple critical aerostructure production facilities directly to Airbus ownership as part of a larger corporate restructuring. The transaction, announced on April 28, 2025, is intended to simplify operations ahead of Spirit's sale to Boeing, which is scheduled to close in the third quarter of this year, pending regulatory approval. Spirit shareholders approved a Boeing acquisition in February 2025. The US\$ 4.7 billion deal will reunite the Wichita-based supplier with its former parent company. Boeing's move is aimed at consolidating supply chain control and enhancing quality oversight for its commercial programs.

While both the Airbus asset divestiture and the Boeing merger are subject to regulatory clearance, they are anticipated to close concurrently later this year. Once completed, they will represent one of the most significant realignments of aerospace manufacturing supply chains in recent history. As part of the deal, Airbus will purchase Spirit's facilities, which are currently used to sustain major Airbus programmes. These comprise theKinston, North Carolina, and St. Nazaire, France, production facilities, both of which produce A350 fuselage sections. The Casablanca, Morocco factory produces components for the A321 and A220, while the Prestwick, Scotland factory produces wing components for the A320 and A350 families. Apart from this, Airbus will also acquire Spirit's A220 pylon manufacturing facility in Wichita, Kansas, and A220 wing assembly facility in Belfast, Northern Ireland. As an alternative, if no third-party buyer is available, Airbus will also acquire Spirit's A220 mid-fuselage production in Belfast and Airbus-related assets in Subang, Malaysia.
