LBA Movements review, October 1994. Things are still fairly healthy on the foreign visitors front, in fact we managed a first visit of type among them this month. Of course there were the usual old favourites as well. On the 2nd Cessna 425 N425HS and Cessna 421C 00-LFH were new for this year but on the 3rd the Duke of Westminster's Citation VR-CDM been seen here quite often. Two more regulars on the 4th were the Humberside based Seneca N31712 and the Dornier 28D BI-CJU which despatches parachutists at Hibbaldstowe. The Dornier arrived for engine checks and stayed until the 8th which included an air-test on the 7th. Night stopping on the 4th was Fortune Aviation's DC9 I-TIAR which was from and to Rimini with a football team and used the callsign "Noman 580". On the 5th we had another visit from the Lakenheath based PA-28 N43069 and a first visit from Citation V OB-GAA of Tyrolean Jet Services. On the 6th Seneca N31712 was back and was joined by Baron F-GHIU which we last saw at the start of the year. The first of a number of Danish visitors this month arrived from Karup on the 10th in the shape of Citation III OY-CCG which used callsign "Alkair 003" A first visit of type on the 12th was the Piaggio Avanti D-IHMO, due to adverse weather at Humberside it diverted in and waited for it to clear, it was joined on the apron for a short while by the Navajo N27495. Another American was Cheyenne I N2356X which arrived from Liverpool on the 13th and stayed until 15th when it departed to Hawarden. Heavier metal on the 14th was the Falcon 900 HB-IAI of Socavia AG coming all the way from Heathrow. Trinidad F-GENJ came from the Isle of Man on the 15th and on the 18th Lear Jet 60 N60UK was from and to Belfast(City). The first of a number of charters to Billund was the new Beech 1900 OY-JRP on the 20th as "Danstrans 9479". On the 21st Airbus 300 00-ING came from Brussels to operate the "Britannia 390A" to Palma, also noted was the Seneca OY-PET which night stopped until the 25th and the second Cheyenne of the month, F-GFVO, arriving from St. Etienne. On the 23rd King Air B90 OY-JRO was "Danstrans 9480" and on the 25th the Seneca OY-PET did a flight to and from Blackpool then night stopped. Night stopping on the 26th was Cessna 425 N1224S from Birmingham and Citation OY-CPW was operating as "Danstrans 9482". The Lear Jet 60 N60UK was back on the 27th but on the 28th it was replaced by the Lear Jet 35 N35UK. Also visiting on the 28th was the Cherokee Six N1351H which booked in from Dartmoor and departed to Shoreham, the King AirB90 OY-JRO operated as "Danstrans 9510" from Sindal to Billund. Final foreiger of the month was Beech 1900 OY-JRP on the 29th "Danstrans 9485". Military visitors were again on the low side with Belfast based Islander ZG844 arriving as "Army452" on the 5th and Gazelle XZ314 calling as "Army398" on the 8th. Tucano 2F376 visited as "LOP 12" on the 11th whilst the Queens Flight used BAe 146 ZE701 as "Kitty 2" on the 14th and the Wessex XV732 as "Kitty 06" on the 23rd. Monarch have been operating a number of charters from here to Jerez during the month, reportedly something to do with the motor trade. A new registration on the 16th was Sikorsky S-76 G-HAUG which arrived from over the water in Ireland and after refuelling went to Leconfield, it returned along the same route about an hour later. Another new registration arrived on the 26th on the ATS Vulcan flight from Southampton, this was Bandeirante G-NBAC which is thought to be ex G-POST on lease from BAC Leasing whilst their G-BLVG is having major checks. On the subject of Bandeirantes the new Knight Air machine G-BVRT is now in service, the Air Camelot Bandit G-BGYV arrived from Tees-side as "Air-Cam 607" on the 14th for checks at Knight Air and Knight Air sent one of their Bandits up to operate the AirCam flights. Whilst G-BGYV was here AirCam decided to go into voluntary liquidation and Knight Air have continued to operate their flights out of Tees-side, they have also taken over the lease of G-BGYV and it is to be added to their fleet as G-JBAC. Tobago G-BKTY which has been in YLA for a long time now suffering from damaged wings after a heavy landing is almost ready to fly again and AA5 G-BEZF which suffered damage to the noseleg in a similar incident is already back in the air.

NORTH AMERICAN HOLIDAY 16 SEPTEMBER, 1994

Air Transat C-GTSJ touched down punctually at Manchester. "Good!" I said. "We'll be away on time." The first announcement said there would be a half hour delay because of problems with a door. Later we were told there would be a further two or three hours wait, but free refreshments would be served.

Delicious sandwiches were followed by biscuits with tea or coffee; and as the minutes ticked by my log book became fuller and fuller. The most interesting were: El Al 4X-EBR (757), Air Foyle N923SJ, Ambassador SX-BSJ, Canada 3000 C-FX00 (757), Lauda OE-LRC, Air Littoral F-GHIA (Brasilia), Ecu Air SE-DPP (L1011), Quantas VH-OJK (747) and Challengair 00-JOT. I also saw a Cathay Pacific, an Air Hong Kong and a foreign military Hercules.

Despite the delay I like Air Transat. They apologised for the late start, which had necessitated having a spare part flown up from London on the Shuttle. The seats on our 757 were comfortable. There was ample leg room, the flight attendants were friendly, and a film was shown. The hot meal was excellent, too; and there was no smoking anywhere on the aircraft.

Previously when flying to Toronto we'd flown over Greenland, enabling us to see the snow covered mountains below us. This time we stayed over the sea with the land to our right. The mountains along the coast were barren. The ones further inland were snow-capped, but those beyond were completely white, as were the valleys between them.

Eventually, four hours and two minutes late, we landed at Toronto where the first plane I saw was a British Airways 747, G-AWNL. There were the usual Canadian carriers including Royal's C-GRYP, a U.S. Air and BWIA's 9Y-THX. My sister-in-law Dorothy, while waiting for us, logged LOT SP-LOA, which is a 767-25DER named 'Gneizao'. I was sorry I'd missed it. I've never seen a Polish plane.

At Niagara Falls helicopters flew sightseeing tours over the falls. But it wasn't until we were in the U.S.A. that we discovered any more airfields.

Detroit Metro Airport was as busy as ever with arrivals and departures about every two minutes at the rush hour. Most of the planes were Northwest. But we also saw Southwest, TWA, Delta, American Trans Air, MGM Grand Air, American Airlines, Buffalo Airways and Continental. On the freight side were Federal Express, a Polar Air Cargo 747 and United Parcel Service's N750 UP.

Although I've gone plane spotting at Detroit Metro many times during my four visits to the U.S.A., I've never been into the terminal building because there's a wonderful vantage point by the perimeter fence near the end of one of the runways. The aircraft are so low that you can read the numbers without binoculars as they come in to land.

Sadly, less than a mile away, there's a memorial. It's in memory of the passengers and crew who died when an airliner, failing to gain sufficient height, caught a wing on a building and crashed shortly after take off.

Beside the 406 Freeway near Prudeholmes Village, a small seaplane was moored on a lake; and at a strip alongside U.S. Highway 5 near Buffalo, N.Y., a Mercy Flight helicopter awaited its next emergency call. We inspected the aerodrome at Erie, Pennsylvania. There was a hangar with "Erie Airways Inc." above the door, and one medium sized plane stood on the apron—that was all.

Burke Airport at Cleveland, Ohio was busier. As we dashed past I jotted down two registrations from among the many light aircraft. They were N8916W and N73260. I don't like American registrations. They start with N. Then come one or more numbers which are often, but not always, followed by one or two letters. They're not as easy to remember as all-letter identifications.

We stopped at Griffing Sandusky Airport, Ohio. There were several light aircraft on the apron which adjoins the car park without even a dividing fence; and a plane landed while we were watching. But dominating the scene was a smart executive type jet registered N31RC. The terminal building was small but modern, outside which were two car park spaces marked "US Customs." A big hangar nearby had "Piper" painted onit, and that was as much of the layout as we could see.

Back on our travels we passed a farm field with a few small aeroplanes parked up. This was alongside US Highway 24 on the south side of Monroe, Michigan; and a bit further on, a signpost pointed to Custer where there's an airstrip.

We also discovered Shamrock Airport (and not an Aer Lingus in sight!) This is at Brooklyn, Michigan. It has a grass runway complete with lights to facilitate after dark operation. We were made welcome and invited to inspect the hangar, where several small aircraft were being worked on. The most interesting was N64202, an old Fairchild with two open cockpits. Also there was N2052K which was a Luscombe. Our friendly guide told us that at Jackson County Airport—also known as Reynolds Field—there was an experimental aircraft association that welcomed visitors. However, when we located Jackson, the association's building had closed for the day. Nevertheless, a hangar belonging to Bocrom Aircraft was open, and some planes were being repaired. Jackson County Airport is quite big. There's a Cessna Pilot Centre with "Discover Flying" painted onit, and there are some scheduled domestic services using it. The gate guardian, perched high on a post, bears the number N68068, but we couldn't decide whether it was a real aircraft or a mock-up.

About eleven miles from Jackson we drove past Napoleon Airfield which has a grass runway. A medium sized propeller aircraft, N3434, was parked up. Other small airfields seen in Michigan were Ionia County Airport, Manistee Blacker Airport and Evart Municipal Airport. There was also an unnamed grass strip somewhere in Leelanau National Park. The most disappointing one was an airport near Reed City. Despite a roadsign pointing to it, the aerodrome had closed down; and like all abandoned airfields it was a sad sight with its disused runway and semi-derelict terminal building.

All too soon we were crossing from Detroit, U.S.A. to Windsor, Canada for a final night's stay in Niagara Falls City on our way to Toronto and home. Light aircraft were logged at three aerodromes: Windsor, Niagara District and St. Thomas. Eventually we boarded Air Transat's C-FTNH at Toronto. It was an L1011 Tristar. On the way to Manchester we called at Edinburgh to allow some passengers to disembark, others bound for Canada to come on board, and to change the crew. There was a long delay because the baggage handlers had never had to work on an L1011 before; and two of the plane's crew had to go and sort them out.

Air Transat is, according to their in-flight magazine "Globe Trotter," Canada's biggest charter air carrier. They fly to the U.S.A, Mexico, the Carribean, Central and South America. They also do summer charters to the U.K., Germany, France, Belgium, Holland, Greece, Portugal, Italy and the Republic of Ireland. Their scheduled services include Toronto to Halifax, Charlottetown, Gander, Calgary and Vancouver. From Calgary they fly to Vancouver and Montreal; and there's a service between Montreal and Vancouver. The summer, 1994 issue of their magazine says they have twelve aircraft.
