He recognises the early difficulties, but leads into the ever increasing accuracy and impact of the air war on Germany. He also develops views on the so-called moral issues.

## Visit to Liverpool/Ravenair.... Howard Griffin

#### John Lennon strikes all the right chords.

Taking over the position of trips organiser from Mike Storey was a tall order and I hope to organise different trips to add a bit of variety hence the visit to Linton-on-Ouse and now the visit to one of our nearest major GA fields that also has commercial traffic in LPL; a rarity nowadays. If you look at LBA, NCL, EDI, MAN etc.. commercial traffic has all but forced out the General Aviation activity that kept those airports open before the low cost carriers muscled their way in. The demise of PTT may turn out to be related to the fact they operated from commercial airports rather that purely GA airfields with their lower operating costs but we will probably never know.

Back to Liverpool. Ever since the new terminal was built, spotting here has been a nightmare limited to the car parks of the neighbouring supermarkets. That period has also seen a rapid growth at the major FBO: Ravenair who have reportedly the world's largest single fleet of Partenavia P68's and Aerial Survey work is high on their list of services; I still remember the Islander of BKS air Surveys in the YLA hangar at LBA and the DC3's of Fairey based at Manchester.



We all arrived on time at 11 am even with the terrible traffic round Manchester. It was a glorious morning with not a cloud in the sky. We walked up and then found our way barred by gates, gates and yes more gates! a quick finger on the buzzer saw us through and a short walk brought us to the main entrance to Ravenair whereupon Gary went off to sign us in and introduce our host Robert Saile to us. Magic, all worked like clockwork. But- we should have worn high-viz jackets (one for next time). Airside passes were handed out and we were away.

There are 3 hangars at LPL, 2 for Ravenair and 1 for Keenair, Robert explained we had the run of their 2 and he would try to get us into the Keenair hangar that had in his terms "a nice few oldies and goodies including a Harvard". He also explained that only aircraft of less than 10 tonnes could use their apron as the rest had to operate from the main apron next to the terminal (A Cessna 560 Excel is 9.2 tonnes). First on the agenda was a good look round one of the P68's with a hole in the floor. We asked why P68's ? Answer: because they can be modified, plus they fly slow (an essential characteristic when mapping), high winged to ease

photography, plentiful supply, and lower operating costs than a helicopter. Ravenair operate the largest collection of P68's probably in the world with one in Europe having 5 examples versus their 12.Makes sense really – especially as 2 were away in Holland doing just that – mapping, where do you think the photos come from for google maps, Ordinance Survey etc..?. Whilst walking about, also have to watch movements at LPL as two of the 3 Aztecs departed whilst were on the apron plus the usual Ryanair and Easyjet.

Next was into the maintenance hangar with a few aircraft in it plus a broken P68 acting as a spares ship. Right at the back was what could be described as a cupboard with the remains of a Cessna 340 in it; EI-CIJ (CSN 073) EX G-BBVE acting as a cockpit simulator soon to be replaced with a B737 cockpit so watch for that..( Impossible to see this without a visit). Also how long it will remain is in doubt as the new B737 cockpit is due to arrive soon.

Next door and we had a lovely TBM750 plus a star in Cessna 165 G-BTDE that is only 1 of 3 in the whole country and is kept in pristine condition. I managed to get a photo of the cockpit which shows the complexity of this very early Cessna with an unusual rotary engine, but in the hangar next door (Keenair) was a Harvard plus a glorious Miles M.65 Gemini 1A in G-AKKB. We had to go via the flying school to get to that hangar - another offshoot of Ravenair, who are benefitting from the demise of

PTT, with their fleet of P38 Tomahawks. Asking about maintaining aircraft, we were informed that apart from engines that had TBO's etc (time between overhauls) the wings also needed replacing regularly but the fuselage could go on for ever.

It was then we really went airside with a run round the apron that included our usual group photo. This was shot right in front of a brand new TBM930 G-WMRN that cost in the region of \$3 million. I want one!

This Schleicher KA 6CR-PE G-DGBE/BGA3696, universally referred to as the K-6 arrived in Eaglescliffe on the 23 April having been transported by road from The Gliding Centre at Husbands Bosworth in Leicestershire were it was resident even though most aviation databases gives it's home location as being with the Buckminster Gliding Club based at Saltby in Lincolnshire. Built in 1963

and first registered as D-4085, c/n 6133/A, the glider was recently found to have weak joints within the wings which would snap off with only a light hand pressure applied. The fault is well known within gliding circles and is due to the type of glue used during construction.

The owner and his daughter who are both glider pilots at the Yorkshire Gliding Club at Sutton Bank intend to remove the cockpit section and convert it into a flight-simulator with the fuselage destined to become a garden ornament!

#### LEEDS/BRADFORD NEWS

After a long delay, Jet2's latest Boeing 737-800, G-JZBP arrived at LBA on a rather misty 11th October. The aircraft is in Jet2 Holidays colours, but again was delivered minus the sunburst tail. Jet2 have obviously got the fitting of seats and post delivery checks down to a fine art now, as the aircraft departed LBA on the 13th for its 1st "tour of duty" operating from Newcastle. It entered service that very day, its 1st revenue service been a Tenerife rotation. G-DRTN arrived as Lasham on the 28th September. This is the 1st of a further 9, pre owned Boeing 737-800's acquired by Jet2. They are allocated registrations G-DRTG to G-DRTOAs we close for press, Boeing 737-300, G-CELH, has been put out to grass, spending the last two weeks on Multiflight East apron, minus and Jet2 logo's of markings. No doubt its final flight to meet the scrap man is not too far away. STOP PRESS JUST DEPARTED THIS MORNING 22/10, TO LASHAM!!!!

A report on PPrune suggests the following further Srs 300 retirement dates GCELX is due to perform its last flight on the 4th Nov and will start the retirement process on the 5th. GCELV will retire shortly after this on the 7th/8th NovemberGCELO will retire around the 22nd November. Out of the original G-CE series of registrations only G-CELE and G-CELY will then remain in service. Of course all the above is very subject to change !!

Edinburgh is confirmed as an all Boeing 737-800 base by mid December and Newcastle will be also all Boeing 737-800 by end of April. This will only leave EMA, Belfast and of course LBA with the 300 series aircraft based for summer 2019.

#### **AIRPORT NEWS**

Gatwick Airport has set out a controversial vision for its future with the publication of a new draft master plan. Among the options on the table is the routine use of the current standby runway, a suggestion which has angered local residents and environmental campaigners. However, this is just one of three options open Gatwick said. The draft master plan was announced to the airport's independent consultative committee GATCOM. The publication reflects department for transport guidance for airports to provide regular updates on their long-term plans and responds to a recent call for airports to 'make best use of their existing runways'. In the near term, the airport has considered how deploying new technology could increase the capacity of the main runway, offering incremental growth through more efficient operations. Gatwick has successfully utilised its runway to unlock growth in recent years and remains the world's most efficient single runway. The use of the latest technology could provide more opportunities for the future. Under its current planning agreement, Gatwick's existing standby runway is only used when the main runway is closed for maintenance or emergencies. However, the 40-year planning agreement will come to an end in 2019. The draft master plan sets out for the first time how Gatwick could potentially bring its existing standby runway into routine use for departing flights, alongside its main runway, by the mid-2020s. This development, which would meet all international safety requirements, would be delivered without increasing the airport's noise footprint and provide greater operational resilience. Gatwick said. Should the airport decide to further progress the use of the existing standby runway, it would submit a detailed planning proposal and follow a Development Consent Order process, which would include a full public consultation.

#### **AIRLINE NEWS**

**Flybe** share price crash by more than a third in mid October, after a trading update revealed its full year adjusted profit figure would be "lower than market expectations". The carrier said it has seen good revenue performance in the first half set against the backdrop of increasingly adverse fuel and currency impacts. Recent trading, however, indicated a softening in the second half of the year. Flybe now expects profits for the first half of 2018 to be around £9.4 million. Flybe's strategy to reduce capacity to focus on its most popular routes has delivered both higher load factors and revenue per seat. In quarter two, load factors were up year-on-year by 7.2 percentage points to 86.6 per cent, a record load factor for the summer season. Passenger revenue per seat was up 6.8 per cent as capacity reduced by ten per cent.

**Jet2 Holidays** new figures show a big increase in the number of Atol-protected passengers. The operator is now licensed for 3.8 million passengers, an increase of around 800,000 in the last six months and a leap from the 2.94 million it was licensed for 12 months ago. Now ranked the number two operator, Jet2 Holidays are now well clear of rival Thomas Cook, whose main Atol now accounts for 2.47 million passengers, an increase of less than 82,000 in the last year. The Atol top 10 gives an indication of which companies are expanding and are an indication of their plans for the year ahead. Tui UK remains top of the league, licensed for 5.68 million, compared with 5.39 million a year ago.

Primera Air has ceased all operations after a failed long-haul expansion drove the company out of business. The budget carrier had a fleet of 15 aircraft and predominantly flew Scandinavian holidaymakers to resorts in Spain, Greece, Italy, Egypt and Turkey. However, earlier this year it launched long-haul services from the United Kingdom to destinations in North America. Services to Washington, Newark, and Toronto in the United States and Canada were unveiled from Stansted in London over the past 12 months, but all have now ceased. It appears the move to a low-cost long-haul model did not pay off for the airline. Problems began to appear earlier this year when Primera cancelled services from Birmingham. At the time in blamed the late arrival of deliveries from Airbus for the decision. "On this sad day we are saving goodbye to all of you," the carrier said in a statement on its website earlier. Primera said its IATA codes, PF and 6F, had been suspended as of October 2nd. The Danish-registered airline which started in 2003 as a charter provider - said phone and email contact would no longer be possible. Tour operator passengers were urged to contact agents for further information. However, the carrier was not part of the ATOL Protection scheme offered by the CAA. This only covers passengers booked on package holidays. The regulator has consequently advised passengers who have travelled on an outward Primera flight they will need to make their own arrangements to return to the UK. Those who have booked directly with the airline on future flights will also not be covered. Passengers who used either a credit, charge or debit card may be able to make a claim against their card provider, the CAA said.

Ryanair has reported profits of €1.20 billion for the first half of financial 2018, a seven per cent fall on the same period last year. Average fares declined three per cent due to excess capacity in Europe, an earlier Easter in quarter one and repeated air traffic control strikes. The latter caused a spike in cancellations of higher fare, weekend flights. Ryanair chief executive, Michael O'Leary, said: "Our traffic, which was repeatedly impacted by the worst summer of air traffic control disruptions on record, grew six per cent at an unchanged 96 per cent load factor." The Irish low-cost carrier has also been hit by a wave of strikes among staff across Europe after it recognised unions for the first time in late 2017. "Ryanair has shown over the past ten months that we can, and will, work with unions to reach fair and reasonable agreements for our people while retaining our competitiveness and efficiency," explained a statement to markets." We can also manage strikes, although we do our utmost to avoid them. "We will continue to negotiate and conclude union agreements over this winter. "While we hope to finalise more union agreements in the coming months, we cannot rule out occasional industrial action, but we expect their impact to be very limited."Revenue stood at €4.79 for the six months to September 30th, up eight per cent on the same period last year. Ryanair took delivery of 23

new Boeing 737s during the period. The carrier will deploy the planes at new bases in Bordeaux, Marseille, London Southend next year, as well as increasing capacity in Luton. With Brexit now just months away, Ryanair said the risks of a no deal scenario were rising. "While we hope that a 21-month transition agreement from March 2019 to December 2020 will be implemented (and extended), we remain concerned that the time to complete such an agreement is shortening," added a statement. "In the event of a hard Brexit our UK shareholders will be treated as non-EU. "In such an event the board will restrict the voting rights of all non-EU shareholders (and confine them to selling shares only to EU nationals) to ensure that Ryanair remains majority owned and controlled by EU shareholders."

#### OTHER NEWS

The shortest airport runway in the world has been reopened. Juancho E. Yrausquin Airport, as the airport is officially called, is located on the Dutch Caribbean island of Saba. Its runway 12/30 is a whopping 400 metres or 1,312 feet long, and thereby officially the shortest runway at a passenger flight served airport. It was closed between 10 September until 9 October for renovations, with the new project replacing the runway's current asphalt layer with a new concrete runway. During the four-week renovation project, tourism officials said there would be three additional ferry services from St Maarten to Saba, with ferries running twice daily in each direction. Commercial airlines such as Winair and Windward Express were not allowed to fly during the renovation while one helicopter pad remained open for medical emergencies. Twin Otter , PJ-WII, of Winair had the honour of performing the first flight

Sixty years ago, British Airways, then called British Overseas Airways Corporation, became the first airline to fly a turbo jet engine aircraft between Europe and New York, reducing the journey time from 18 hours to around seven. On October 4th, 1958 the airline flew two de Havilland Comet 4 aircraft, one from New York to London and the other from London to New York. One of the original cabin crew members, Peggy Thorne, 91, had joined BOAC in 1950 and was hand-picked to serve customers on the first flight. British Airways hosted Peggy, and captain Hugh Dibley, a former Comet 4 navigator, at an event to celebrate the historic achievement."It was marvellous," Peggy remembers. "We were used to travelling to New York on Boeing Stratocruisers which took up to 20 hours. "We couldn't believe the flight was possible in such a short time."US airline Pan Am had been promising that it would be the first airline to do this but was beaten by Britain's BOAC with its new jet engine aircraft by several weeks. At the time it made front page headlines. Back in 1958, Comet 4 could fly just 48 customers every day from London, Today British Airways operates up to 12 flights a day from the capital, offering around 3,500 seats. On the Comet there were two cabins, Deluxe and First Class. Today, British Airways flights feature four cabins, to suit all budgets - World Traveller, World Traveller Plus, Club World and First.In 1958 a ticket to travel on the Comet staggeringly cost the equivalent of £8,000. Captain Dibley commented,: "The Comet 4 was delivered to BOAC on September 30th and flew across the Atlantic on October 4th, which was quite a surprise to some people, not least because it was so fast!" With just a few months left before British Airways begins its Centenary celebrations, Alex Cruz, British Airways chief executive, paid tribute to the crew of the first flights He said: "British Airways and its predecessors have always pioneered innovation and hospitality, and this is a great early example. "Next year we celebrate 100 years of taking Britain to the world and bringing the world to Britain, and the quality of service we provide to customers is better than ever."
