It was back to Sunday afternoon for the August meeting when 29 members attended for a presentation on 'British Piston-Engined Transport Aircraft since WWII', which was given by Martin Powell and Ivor Tamplin of the Rossendale Aviation Society. Beginning with the DH Dragon Rapide each type was introduced with a text slide followed by photos. Many well-known types were illustrated including the Avro Anson, York and Lancastrian, the Handley Page Halifax and Hermes and the Bristol Freighter. The Shorts Sunderland 3 Flying Boat was discussed and one of these was shown painted in the old Ryanair colours, much to the amusement of those present. There were also some less well-known aircraft like the Cunliffe Owen Concordia of which only two were built.

After a short break the meeting resumed with a discussion of the work of the Brabazon Committee considering the future needs of civil air transport after the war. This report identified five categories relating to aircraft size and type of power - piston or turbine. An example was the Bristol Brabazon which was Category 1 - large aircraft for North Atlantic routes, only one of these was completed and one semi-completed. Other types featured (I never realised there were so many!) included Scottish Aviation Pioneer and Twin Pioneer, Vickers Varsity and the Shorts Skyvan since one was built with piston engines.A Question and Answer session followed which included discussion on the success or otherwise of various British and American types and the meeting closed with the usual presentation of bottles of wine to the speakers. I am sure we can look forward to welcoming Martin and Ivor back again for their feature on British Turbine-Engined Transport aircraft sometime soon.

The big news and sad news this month is that Easyjet are withdrawing their flights at the end of the summer season even though they are reporting good load factors. It has been another fairly quiet month in South Yorkshire with just a couple of freight charters worthy of note, AN-26 LY-APN(LVR 102) on 6/7 and Icelandair Boeing 757 TF-FIG(Iceair 781) on 24/7. In addition there were two Pilgrims charters from Lourdes on 2/7, however these are detailed in the listing below. Kinch Aviation continue to attract interesting aircraft with the star this month being Citation 2 VT-SGT which arrived on 12/7 on delivery from India. This aircraft will eventually be based at LBIA after having been repainted as N425ST, a replacement for Cessna 425 N425SL. WADDINGTON:- RAF WADDINGTON AWARDED STAINFORTH TROPHY:-

RAF Waddington has been chosen as this year's winner of the prestigious Stainforth Trophy – the most prestigious award in the RAF calendar.Named in memory of heroic flyer Wing Commander George Stainforth, the trophy is awarded annually by the Commander-in-Chief Air Command to the station whose overall performance in the preceding calendar year has contributed the most towards the delivery of air power.The Station's contributions to operations in Afghanistan, and its achievements in the local community, proved to be a winning combination, enabling Waddington to fight off stiff competition and strong entries from other units within Air Command.

There were many notable achievements on operations in 2009, which saw all of RAF Waddington's force elements deployed on operations, delivering valuable air power effect in Afghanistan and elsewhere. And despite demanding operational tempo, the Station also managed to maintain a high profile in the local community, not least by delivering a record-breaking air show which attracted

some 170,000 visitors. Other charity endeavours raised thousands of pounds, and cemented the strong bond between the Station and the local community.

Station Commander, Group Captain Rich Powell, said: "I am delighted to announce that RAF Waddington has been chosen as this year's winner of the Stainforth Trophy. "This is a tremendous achievement, and one of which all personnel at Waddington should be immensely proud. 2009 was an exceptionally busy year for us all and this award recognises our contribution to the delivery of air power, but also our achievements in enhancing the reputation of the RAF. "All of you - Servicemen and women, civil servants and contractors from all areas of the Station - should be proud of your achievements. I thank you all for your continuing hard work and determination," he added. Writing to congratulate the Station, the Command-in-Chief Air Command, Air Chief Marshal Sir Chris Moran, said: "You can be justifiably proud of your selection for this prestigious award. RAF Waddington stood out for its outstanding contribution to operations and to the community more widely. The award of the Stainforth Trophy is thoroughly well deserved recognition of your sterling efforts throughout 2009." Wing Commander George Stainforth, who was killed on operations in 1942, was part of the famous High-Speed Flight which won the Schneider Trophy in 1931 for the third year in a row, thereby securing the trophy for the UK. He was also the first man to break the 400 mph barrier, winning an Air Force Cross in the process. The spectacular trophy, depicting three ascending supersonic aircraft with spiralling vapour trails, was first awarded in 1974. It will be presented to the Station by a senior RAF officer in the near future, and it is expected that a member of the Stainforth family will be present for the event. Life is great amongst the greatest birds in the sky.

The Passenger figures were again affected by cancellations due to the Icelandic Ash Cloud, so these are not a true representation on the state of the traffic through the airport.

Having said that an increase of 4.9% over May 2009 is again a very creditable performance. It is the highest year on year figure since I began collating these figures in August 2008. The movements which show an increase of 8.14% is even better as it is the first increase since March 2009 and that was skewed by to a surge in Private/Misc flying that month.

With regard to International passengers there were 18 routes that showed an increase over May 2009, the best being Monastir (+276%), Malta (+242%), Murcia (+45%), Faro(+33%) and Malaga (+29%). The routes showing reductions amounted to 27, with the worst being Larnaca (-76%), Innsbruck (-73%), Heraklion (-65%), Toulouse (-52%) and Olbia (-40%). The routes with the most passengers were Palma, Malaga, Alicante, Amsterdam and Dublin.

Domestically, the average reduction in Passengers year on Year was 21%, however the situation improves when the new Gatwick service is included, resulting in a small decline of about 1.6%. The only route to increase in numbers was Plymouth with a 21% increase. The most popular route is Southampton followed by Belfast City. Belfast International and then Gatwick.

For the record there were 10 diversions away from Leeds/Bradford and none received.

LEEDS/BRADFORD NEWS

Flybe celebrated its 2,000,000th passenger at Leeds Bradford Airport on the 22nd July, with a special presentation to Wakefield businessman, Mike Roberts, when he arrived from his day return flight to Gatwick, one of Flybe's five routes to and from the airport.

To celebrate this milestone, Mr Roberts was presented with a commemorative Flybe magnum of Champagne by airport Commercial Director, Tony Hallwood, together with a six month Premier Lounge pass at both Leeds Bradford and Flybe's dedicated Executive Lounge at Gatwick.

However a few days later this article appeared in *The Yorkshire Post*. A high-speed rail link from London to Leeds will dramatically reduce air travel from Leeds Bradford Airport. Transport Secretary Philip Hammond told MPs that one of the reasons he supports plans for super-fast trains connecting London to the North was because it will eventually replace the need for domestic flights.

Mr Hammond also said in an 'ideal world' he would like to see the 250mph trains connected right through to the Channel Tunnel, which would also reduce the need for flights from Leeds Bradford to places like Paris and Amsterdam. Appearing before the transport select committee, He said such a switch from domestic and short haul flights to rail would have a 'transformational' affect on the economy. However, bosses at Leeds Bradford International Airport disagree, predicting that both domestic and short-haul travel from the airport will increase, even when high-speed rail is up and running. Tony Hallwood, the airport's commercial director, pointed out that its airlines fly to domestic destinations that will not be served by high-speed rail – like the south coast and south west of England, Scotland and the Republic of Ireland. Flights between Schiphol and Leeds will also continue to be important because they allow passengers to get from the continent to Yorkshire without having to travel via London, he added.

Following overwhelming demand, Jet2.com, has increased its dedicated service for pilgrims taking part in this year's annual Hajj, with the announcement of specialist departures from Leeds Bradford, Manchester and East Midlands airports from 1st November 2010. The flights represent a significant increase in dedicated departures from the Midlands and North of England to the Hajj, and are the only direct services available from Leeds Bradford and East Midlands.

Working in partnership with travel agents Sky-Fly Connections Ltd in Bradford and PAK Travels Ltd in Birmingham, the specialist Jet2.com programme is set to carry over 2,000 passengers to Jeddah in Saudi Arabia to take part in the annual Hajj, the world's largest annual pilgrimage. The pilgrimage is regarded as hugely important and every able-bodied Muslim who can afford to do so is required to make the journey at least once in their lifetime.

Jet2.com will be operating a total of 10 return trips - four from Leeds Bradford, four from Manchester and two from East Midlands, representing a 300% increase on last year's hugely successful service, which saw three flights leave from Leeds. Furthermore, Jet2.com will respect Muslim tradition by ensuring that all catering adheres to Halal methods, there is no alcohol served and aircraft crew are sensitive to the practice of prayer whilst in flight. Prayer facilities will also be available in the airport terminal prior to departure. Jet2.com will also be increasing it's already generous baggage allowance of 22kg for pilgrims to bring back the important Zam Zam holy water. Philip Meeson, boss of Jet2.com commented: "Our specialist Hajj flights were extremely popular last year and it is fantastic that we are able to offer an increased service from even more of our airport bases for 2010. We are very keen to listen to the needs of our customers and it is obvious that there is huge demand amongst the Muslim community for dedicated flights to Jeddah during November. Working closely with Sky-Fly Connections and PAK Travels, we are proud of our Hajj offering and are confident that the route will continue to build on the success of last year's operation."

Dash 8 G-ECOF was ferried from Athens to Norwich on 3/8 for repainting into Flybe scheme following its lease to Olympic Air. The carrier is to operate three Dash 8's on behalf of Finnair from the end of October through to the end of next summer.

AIRPORT NEWS

The government has ruled out increasing capacity at **Heathrow** on existing runways through mixed-mode operation – allowing aircraft to take off and land on the same runway. Transport secretary Philip Hammond told MPs on the transport select committee yesterday: 'We are not in favour of mixed-mode operation at Heathrow. The disbenefits to local communities outweigh the benefits.'The previous government rejected a move to mixed-mode operation at the airport in early 2009, but approved plans for a third runway, having previously appeared keen to proceed with both. The new coalition

government scrapped runway expansion plans immediately following its formation in May. Heathrow's two runways are restricted to take-off or landing and switch each afternoon. Aircraft are louder on taking off and this gives local residents some relief from the noise. Mr Hammond also rejected the idea that regional airports could expand in place of Heathrow, rejected London mayor Boris Johnson's plan for a new airport to replace Heathrow and restated the government's commitment to moving domestic traffic from air to rail. He said: 'We recognise regional airports can have a significant effect on a local area, but the role of regional airports is different. It is not obvious the UK can support more than one international hub airport. We are not thinking of moving Heathrow, I can promise.'

'The challenge is to maintain Heathrow as an international hub. Switching traffic from air to rail will be important part of ensuring [that]. It's the government's clear objective to secure Heathrow's future within the constraints of two runways.' A high-speed rail network would be vital, he added, but warned: 'It will not be cheap and will take the best part of three decades.'

Essential repairs to Heathrow taxiways mean residents in north Feltham, south Hounslow, Isleworth and Richmond face more noise for six weeks. Work to fix the taxiways is set to begin in mid September and will mean it is unable to operate runway alteration, denying people living under the flight path their usual half-day of peace for six weeks. The change means during days with westerly winds, which are most common, anyone living to the east of the southern runway will have to put up with planes approaching overhead throughout the day. Residents living west of the northern runway will also be affected, with planes taking off towards Windsor all day. When there is an easterly wind, which happens about a quarter of the time, the usual practice will not change, meaning planes will take off from the southern runway, over Hounslow, Feltham and Richmond, and fly over Windsor to land on the northern runway. Runway alternation will continue as usual during the night, when there are fewer flights. A spokesman for Heathrow said the work had to be carried out urgently because some of the concrete blocks under the taxiways by the northern runway were in danger of becoming unstable. This could lead to the asphalt breaking up posing a risk of debris getting into aircraft engines. He said: 'I know this news will not be welcomed and we want to convey our apologies to all affected. We would not suspend alternation if there was any other alternative. This work is critical to the future safe operation of Heathrow.'

Manchester Airport is to be connected to the city centre by tram link by 2016. The decision to give the green light to three new connections for the city's Metrolink tram system was taken in a meeting of the Association of Greater Manchester Authorities (AGMA). Some £0.5 billion has been committed from the Greater Manchester Transport Fund to connect Manchester Airport to the tram system by the middle of 2016. Oldham and Rochdale town centres will both also be served by the trams by spring 2014. Geoff Muirhead, chief executive of the Manchester Airports Group, said: 'We are delighted at this news. We have been long standing supporters of the Metrolink extension since it was first proposed.' He added that the hub has already invested £100 million in the airport station facilities.

AIRLINE NEWS

British Airways is to bring a Boeing 747 out of storage in the Mojave Desert so that it can be reintroduced into service. The plane is being brought back from the Californian desert later this year and will be used on the Dallas route this winter. The move will free up the Boeing 777 currently used on the Dallas route, which will be switched to the lucrative New York - Heathrow route, increasing the number of flights BA operates each day from six to seven. The reintroduction of a mothballed plane is a sign for the recovery of demand for BA and aviation in general.

B.A. is also to finally withdraw the Boeing 757 from service at the end of October this year. British Airways along with Eastern Airlines in the U.S.A. were the first airlines to introduce the '757 in 1983. One aircraft will operate an enthusiast's charter from Heathrow on the 6th November; the flight will include an overshoot at Manchester.

easyJet has been told it has 90 days to get more of its flights running on time, or it will have to change its name, SKY reports. The warning was given by lawyers for Sir Stelios Haji-loanou, the airline's founder, major shareholder and owner of the easyGroup empire who licences the easy brand to the airline. He is currently in dispute with the airline over its expansion strategy and failure to pay dividends.

In a letter to easyJet's legal team, easyGroup's representatives said recent flight punctuality statistics, particularly those from Gatwick, had generated 'serious and unfavourable' headlines in the national press. It referred to an article in the Sunday Times, which reported that figures it had obtained from Gatwick showed that over half of easyJet flights departed late - a worse record than Air Zimbabwe. easyGroup said the 'embarrassing comparisons' had the 'potential to cause irredeemable harm to the reputation of the airline and to the more general 'easy' brand' if continued for a period of time'. It said it did not accept easyJet's excuse that air traffic control problems were behind the widespread delays, arguing instead that it believed poor management and staffing were to blame. The letter is reported to state: 'Your client is operating in a way that is materially detrimental to and inconsistent with the good name, goodwill, reputation and image of our client and its intellectual property rights. Our client provides easyJet with 90 days' notice... to remedy the breach of clauses by operating at a level of punctuality that preserves and promotes the goodwill associated with easyGroup IP Licensing's intellectual property rights.'The deadline comes at the worst time for the airline, as the busy summer holiday period puts further pressure on tight flight schedules and with more strikes by European air traffic controllers planned. If easyJet does not meet easyGroup's demands by October 17. it will be forced to undertake a costly rebranding of the business.

Flybe has announced an order for up to 140 Embraer E175 Series aircraft to aid its expansion into Europe. The deal comprises 35 firm orders of 88-seat Embraer 175 aircraft with a value of \$1.3 billion (£850 million) with options for 65 more and purchase rights for a further 40, making a potential total order worth \$5 billion. The first aircraft is due to be delivered in September 2011 and the final of the firm orders by March 2017. Flybe Chairman and Chief Executive Jim French, said: 'The 175 will allow us to preserve our two plane fleet strategy. The economic and environmental performance of the aircraft is also in line with Flybe's policy of only buying A and B rated eco-label aircraft as part of its commitment to invest in lower emission new technology aircraft. "We are securing an aircraft that fits with our stated aim of furthering our position as the leading regional airline in Europe. The 175 will give Flybe significant added capacity and is particularly suited to the sector lengths prevalent in Europe that we are most interested in exploiting. This is a good time to buy aircraft and fits Flybe's long tradition of ground-breaking deals which power the long-term growth of the company.'
